- Attendance was documented by acknowledging the names on the Zoom screen. We had 24 people in attendance.
- The agenda items for today’s meeting were reviewed and no other items were added.
 - An opportunity was provided early in today’s meeting for anyone who would like to share without having to wait. Colleen Bradley from PAVE extended invitations to two different virtual Tele-Health events: April 28th, “Tools of Tele-Health, and, May 5th, “What to expect in your Tele-Health visit”.
- Karen Kelly from Washington State Community Connectors (WSCC) was our guest speaker and she provided a presentation on the value of FYSPRT programs and the benefits of partnerships between FYSPRT’s and WISe service providers. Karen shared personal experiences of her and her family that enhanced the connection and relatability between her presentation and those attending this meeting. Karen completed her presentation by entering everyone’s names in a roulette wheel raffle and Sam Latson, our Youth Co-Tri-Lead won a \$25.00 Amazon gift card.
- Sam reminded and encouraged everyone who is eligible for FYSPRT compensation for the month of April to please have their TC-50’s submitted no later than May 5, 2021. Salish BHASO wants to do everything possible to ensure timely compensation tis received by eligible individuals.
- In the remaining time for this meeting attendees discussed some of the challenges faced by students and families of school age children. There seems to be a lot of inconsistency between school districts and their policies regarding how much in-person or remote learning is available. It seems that some families do not feel there is enough effective communication between them and the schools. The percentage of online instruction seems to be minimal while daily hours of homework is high.
