**Family Youth System Partner Round Table (FYSPRT) Meeting Minutes**

1. Introductions: Six individuals attended this meeting, attendance is identified in the following categories:

2. We had hoped to have a prospective Youth Tri-lead in attendance at today’s meeting in our efforts to fill the vacancy in the Youth Tri-lead position. Regretfully, the individual is currently sick and unable to attend. We will set our sights on March for an opportunity to have a prospective Youth Tri-lead in attendance, and in the interim we will continue to solicit any prospective candidates.

3. We engaged in active discussion regarding beneficial presentations to include in our monthly meetings such as:
  - a. DCYF and the Foster Care system
  - b. Volunteers of America and the Crisis Line.
  - c. Individual Education Plans
  - d. Viewing the movies “Paper Lions”, and “Resilience”

We agreed that these presentations would be most beneficial with an increased meeting attendance but also discussed ensuring beneficial presentations are available to assist in encouraging increased attendance.

4. We discussed the need for a decision regarding “Youth Move” technical assistance. Opting to move forward and plan for the technical assistance will likely result in this occurring sometime in the fall of 2020. This will allow an opportunity to reach out to other youth services entities for collaboration and inclusion, ensuring a larger audience is reached to work toward maximum benefit of the Youth Move visit. Ultimately the group voted unanimously to accept the invitation for Youth Move to provide the technical assistance.

5. The group discussed the upcoming Quarterly State FYSPRT meeting planned for Wednesday, Feb 26<sup>th</sup> in Lacey. Ahney, Systems Tri-Lead, plans to attend and Nicole, Family partner Tri-lead, plans to attend.
6. The topic of providing family/youth partners with compensation and mileage reimbursement was discussed by the group. The idea of providing gift cards redeemable at Safeway was discussed and agreed upon. Safeway stores are located in all three counties in this region and gift cards can be redeemed for gas, groceries, hot meals, etc... Sam committed to the group to have a system in place to address this by our next meeting.
7. Consistency of meeting locations was discussed. Travel time and distances are a concern within our region regarding our goal of increasing youth/family partner attendance and participation. The group discussed having two meeting locations linked by internet connection in March. Sam will explore getting a "Zoom" platform for linking meetings in multiple locations.
8. The need to update the one-page FYSPRT program information sheet was discussed. Also, emphasizing important elements including "kids welcome" and travel re-imbusement need to be included.
