- Attendance was documented by acknowledging the names on the Zoom screen. We had 22 people in attendance.
- The agenda items for today’s meeting were reviewed and no other items were added.
  - Sam provided the group a summary of the quarterly FYSPRT report for Oct-Dec 2020. There were several areas where progress was made, notably the increase in Youth, Family, and System Partner Tri-leads.
  - The Five-year strategic plan and the Annual Work Plan were shared with the group.
  - Sam shared about the recent meeting (January 13<sup>th</sup>) between the Salish FYSPRT leadership team and Maggie and Johanna from Youth Move International (YMI). More meetings are to come with YMI to assist Salish FYSPRT in identifying methods to engage youth and increase overall youth involvement in Salish FYSPRT. Sam shared with the group about the meeting he had with Nan Jordan from OESD-114. OESD-114 has offered to present information about Social Work in Schools, and the role of OESD-114 in our schools at our February 22<sup>nd</sup> meeting.
  - The group discussed COVID-19 and the effects on students returning to school, and the inconsistency of vaccine availability.
  - Sam informed the group of progress made to the FYSPRT reimbursement and stipend program.
- Emergency Preparedness and Emergency Response: Nicole Latson facilitated this portion of the meeting and did an excellent job of providing both scripted and unscripted information. See attached PDF.
