- Attendance was documented by acknowledging the names on the Zoom screen. We had 18 people in attendance.
- The agenda items for today’s meeting were reviewed and no other items were added.
 - An opportunity was provided early in today’s meeting for anyone who would like to share or provide an item for the agenda without having to wait. Carolyn Cox from SPARK provided an update regarding the Peer Learning Center for youth ages 18-30. Certified Peer Counselor (CPC) classes are scheduled to begin on July 13th. Classes will be two hours per day, three days per week for six weeks. Once a student completes the curriculum they will have an opportunity to take the test to become a CPC. Students must be 18 years or older to take the CPC test.
- Lisa Lechuga from Kitsap Regional Library System provided an excellent presentation on the resources and programs available through the nine library locations throughout Kitsap county.
- Sam shared two information resources with the group;
 - Safe Kids Virtual Academy: This virtual series offers opportunities for multiple different age groups.
 - Kitsap Homeless and Low-Income Resource Guide: An extensive listing of resources for housing, clothing, food assistance, hygiene, Veteran’s benefits, Youth Services, etc...
- Sam shared with the group about three identified outreach dates in Clallam county in June. Salish FYSPRT has been invited to participate in events in Sequim, Forks, and Port Angeles. Our FYSPRT brochures have been printed and are ready for sharing with our communities. The dates of June 7, 10, and 22 will allow us to make progress on our Annual Work Plan goals.
