Objectives	Description of Objective	
1.	Information sharing throughout the Salish Region Salish FYSVRT will ensure all communities in the region receive information about available services and how to access services.	
	a. Salish FYSVRT will collaborate with WISE service providers and ensure they know about FYSVRT, and that they can inform WISE clients about FYSVRT.	
	b. Salish FYSVRT will collaborate with systems partners to provide a variety of options for administering the annual needs assessment to various elements of the community.	
	c. Salish FYSVRT will create an informational brochure (tri-fold design)	
	d. Salish FYSVRT will create a Survey Monkey to learn why WISE service providers are not inviting and/or attending FYSVRT meetings with WISE clients.	
	e. Salish FYSVRT will attend outreach activities and events (Health Fairs, School Resource Fairs, etc...) to engage with stakeholders and potential FYSVRT members.	
	f. Salish FYSVRT will provide presentation to the regional WISE managers meeting about the mission and	

	vision of FYSPRT.

Priority #2:	Continuous development of Salish FYSPRT Tri-Leads, Systems partners, and Stakeholders	
Objectives	Description of Objective	
1.	Continuous development of Salish FYSPRT Tri-Leads, Systems partners, and Stakeholders Salish FYSPRT will ensure ongoing education and development opportunities are available to current and future youth and family and systems Tri-Leads.	
	a. Salish will maintain at least two family Tri-Leads in each county.	
	b. Salish FYSPRT will identify and recruit specific individuals for Tri-Lead and FYSPRT leadership positions.	
	c. Salish will identify and build relationships with specific organizations and stakeholders.	
	d. Salish FYSPRT Youth and Family Tri-Leads will attend ongoing training opportunities, and the stipend/reimbursement program will be used to the maximum extent in support of this.	
	e. After government regulations allow lifting of COVID-19 restrictions Salish FYSPRT will return to in-person meetings in each county in the region as well as maintaining a virtual (Zoom) option.	
	Measurable Results:	
	1. Salish FYSPRT will maintain two family Tri-Leads per county.	
	2. Specifically identified individuals and organizations will partner with FYSPRT, improving overall quality of program.	
	3. Salish FYSPRT will recruit specific Tribal partners for FYSPRT “Tribal Tri-Lead” leadership positions.	

	4. Salish FYSVRT Tri-Leads will benefit from continued training and development and be better prepared to engage with communities and individuals throughout the region.
	5. Increased utilization of stipend/reimbursement funds in support of youth/family Tri-Lead development.
