She commented on existing programs, summer groups for youth, and new programming PBH will be offering. She indicated PBH has purchased a Motel and converted it to housing. She also indicated that PBH is working with Peninsula College to address the BH workforce shortage. ✓ Lauren Mosley, PBH WISe Services Supervisor, provided an overview of WISe services, staffing, program levels and stability, and program referrals. Lauren shared that two specific barriers for youth/families engaging in WISe services are (1) Medicaid is the only funding source, and 	

		 (2) some you/families live too far out to reasonably engage in services. Sam A encouraged PBH WISe services to encourage referrals to FYSPRT. ✓ Presentation of PBH's services inspired a lot of questions and some lived experience with Clallam based services from several years ago. Overall, the presentation and associated discussion was excellent and received high praise from attendees.
