Youth can get a hot meal, shower, laundry facilities, transportation assistance, inclusion in activities, support for hobbies and interests, mentorship, homeless shelter, and others through Coffee Oasis. Brian shared that youth can receive referrals to SUD and MH counseling and engage in individual and group sessions focused on dealing with the issues they face in life.
