Data that seems to be missing or just not collected is information regarding providing referrals to youth and families during WISe services and at what point referrals are provided prior to discharge from WISe services. The group discussed when, during the WISe episode of care, would it be possible and appropriate for WISe teams to refer youth and families to FYSPRT or provide other care coordination related referrals.
4	Update on January 2024 FYSPRT Family Fun event planning.	✓ Sam A informed the group that our next event is planned for January 27 th , 2024 at the Community Center in Quilcene. The facility has been reserved for noon-5:00 PM. Sam and Annette L plan to meet with the facility director tomorrow at 10:00 AM as part of a FYSPRT outreach. The WISe services supervisor at DBH has expressed interest in participating in the event and sharing event information with DBH WISe clients. Salish FYSPRT will develop a flyer and provide event promotion throughout Jefferson County, with a special emphasis on schools.
