- Attendance was documented by acknowledging the names on the Zoom screen. We had 21 people in attendance.
- The agenda items for today’s meeting were reviewed and no other items were added.
 - As discussed at our January meeting an opportunity was provided early in today’s meeting for anyone who would like to share without having to wait, no one took the opportunity.
- Sam introduced guest presenters from OESD-114 (an Jordan and Mary Rose Dewald and they facilitated a presentation about the work being done by OESD-114 including:
 - Providing social work in schools and how the needs can vary from school to school, and for each person served.
 - The range of OESD-114 services extends throughout the Salish BHASO/FYSPRT region and into other areas as well.
 - Following their formatted presentation both Nan and Mary Rose responded to an extended period of Q&A.
- Kitty provided an update on development of a FYSPRT informational tri-fold, she put the current draft on the screen and explained intended modifications. She and Josie Price plan to change the current logo and utilize the “Publisher” program to continue their work.
- Sam-2 shared that he will not be using PowerPoint to develop an introduction to FYSPRT, instead he will create a series of reader cards and put it into a video format. This idea could do very well in demonstrating the voice of Youth in FYSPRT.
- Sam discussed the FYSPRT reimbursement program and explained that for now we will continue with the current system of TC-50 submissions.

8. Sam informed the group that individuals can check out laptop computers from North Olympic Library System (NOLS) for 2-hour blocks of time at no charge. Users must use the computers curbside at the library location. Interested individuals can contact NOLS for additional information.

9. Sam facilitated a discussion about identifying community outreach opportunities as outlined in our Annual Workplan. So far one opportunity has been identified, the “2021 Annual Kitsap County DD Resource Fair”, to be held virtually for the month of April. More outreach opportunities need to be identified.
