1. Introductions: 24 individuals were in attendance and is identified in the following categories:

- We had one tribal member from the Lower Elwha tribe in attendance.
2. Introductions were done differently today as a result and recommendation from the annual needs assessment. The FYSPRT convener and Tri-Leads each introduced themselves, additional attendees introduced themselves if/when they wanted to provide comments. Attendance was accomplished by documenting those in the “participants” ledger of the Zoom meeting page.
 3. The agenda was reviewed with modifications were proposed.
 - a. There were no follow-up comments regarding the September 2020 meeting.
 - b. Some comments were provided regarding COVID-19 impacts. Kitsap County residents were informed about the availability for online tutoring services for any K-12 student.
 - c. Youth/Family members were reminded about the reimbursement and stipend program to assist with FYSPRT participation.
 4. Two youth commented on how COVID-19 is impacting school. Sam L. indicated he is already “Zoom fatigued” and does not enjoy other activities being unavailable. Shayden discussed that there doesn’t seem to be as much opportunity for classroom assistance when having school via Zoom.

5. Tyler Watson and Alicia Hughes from HealthCare Authority provided an excellent presentation about the “Healthy Youth Survey”. They explained the targeted age groups that participate in the survey (grades 6, 8, 10, and 12) and explained how the resulting data is used. They indicated that questions and suggestions can be submitted, and that further information about the survey can be found at hyshealthyyouthsurvey@hca.wa.gov
6. We had hoped to have a presentation from Tyus Reed regarding “Engaging Youth in Community Efforts” as part of today’s meeting but he was unable to be with us today.
7. The attendees were reminded about an event scheduled for Friday, November 30th at all four Coffee Oasis locations called “Hit the Hay”. This multi-location event provides food (chili and cornbread), candy, fun, and games for anyone wishing to participate, all for free. This event was encouraged for families to do some (safe) social distancing and enjoy food and fun.
8. Our next meeting of Salish Regional FYSPRT is scheduled for November 30, 2020, from 3:00 – 5:00 PM. A Zoom invite will be sent to the entire FYSPRT membership roster. It has been suggested that we do an “ice breaker” at the start of the meeting, ice breaker topics suggested are “something turkey related”, or, “what are you grateful for?”. Either topic is appropriate as our next meeting is just a few days following the Thanksgiving holiday.
